



Competition Details

1. Paintings must be on A3 paper (297× 420 mm: portrait or landscape). Any art medium is allowed e.g. paint, colour pencil etc.
2. Participants must include the following details on the reverse of their work:

Name
Age
Class (e.g. Primary 1)
Name of School
School Address



3. The picture should be of something the participant finds interesting about Japan.
4. Participants should write the title of the picture on the reverse of their work, and a reason why they find it interesting.
5. Entries will be split into the following age groups and judged accordingly:

Primary 1 - Primary 2
Primary 3 - Primary 5
Primary 6 - Primary 7
6. Each age category will have a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner. A special Consul General's prize will also be awarded to the best overall work.
7. The winners' schools will be notified by telephone or letter in May.
8. Winning entries will be exhibited on **10th May** at St John's Church, Edinburgh, during Japan Children's Day, a special event run by the Consulate General of Japan.



Submitted artworks must reach the Consulate General of Japan by **5th May 2014**.
