1. Assistant Language Teacher (ALT)

ALTs work within the school system to promote inter-cultural understanding and improve English language tuition.

(Japanese language ability or teaching qualifications are **not** required)

2. Co-ordinator of International Relations (CIR)

CIRs work in local government offices to promote and develop programmes of cultural exchange.

(Japanese ability sufficient for everyday work is a requirement)
